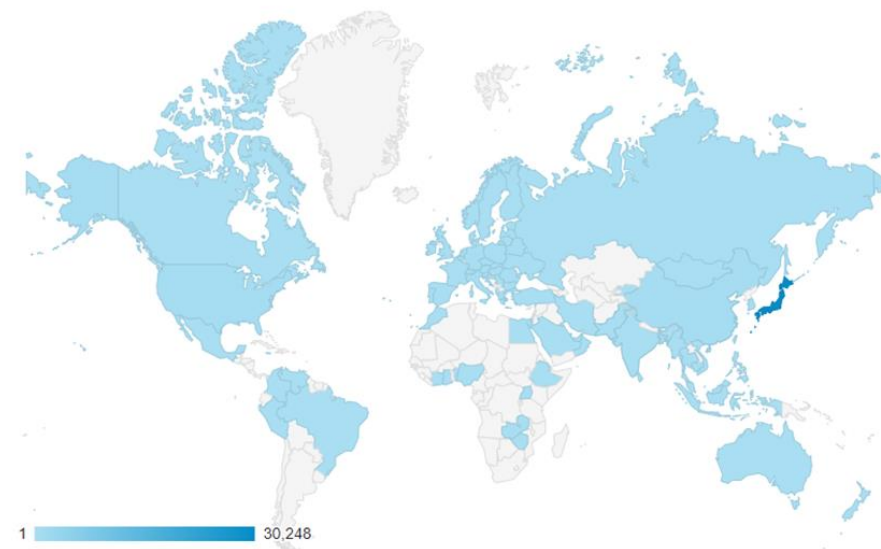

# Brief Introduction to CSRDA

- Established in 1996 and started disseminating raw data in 1998
- Constitutes the following four groups:
  - Research Infrastructure Group
  - Social Survey Research Group
  - Quantitative Social Research Group
  - International Survey Research Group
- Our website is accessed from many countries

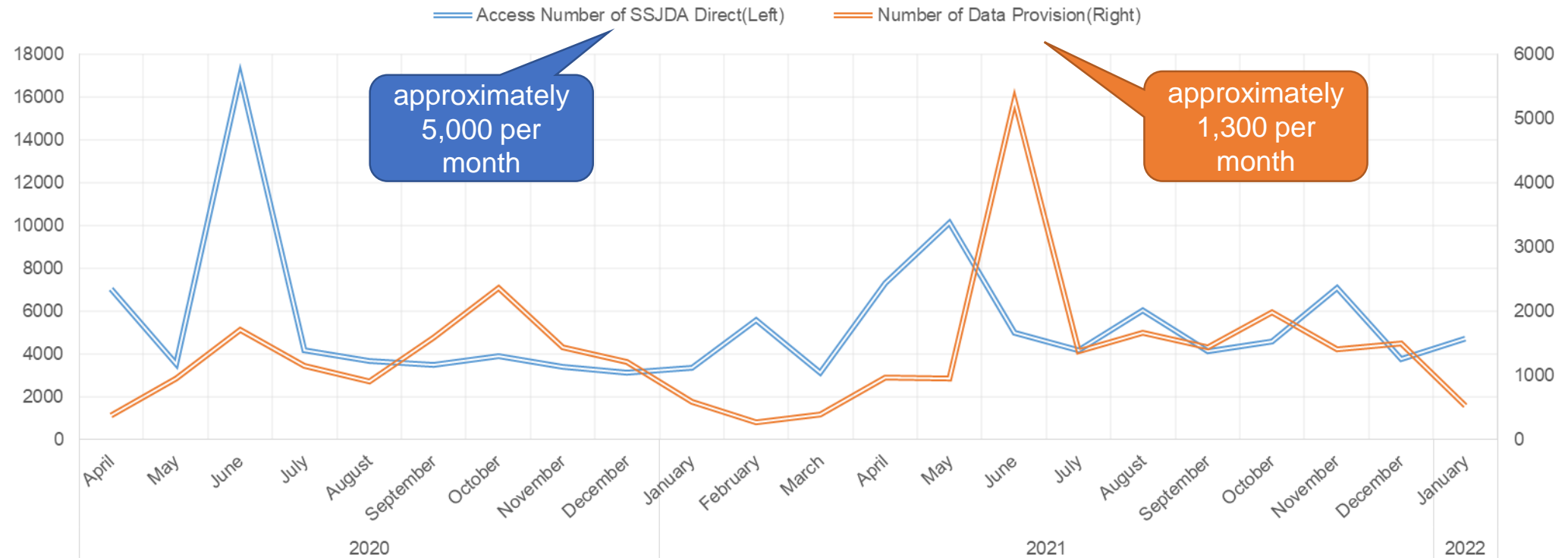

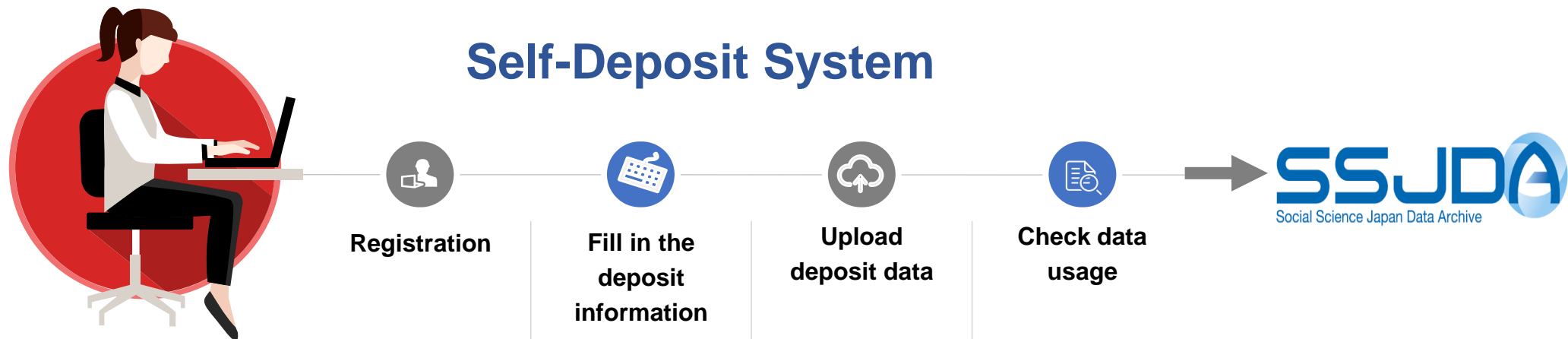
# SSJ Data Archive

- Holds the largest collection of research survey data collected in the field of Social Science in Japan
- More than 2,300 datasets have been released (up to Jan 2022)



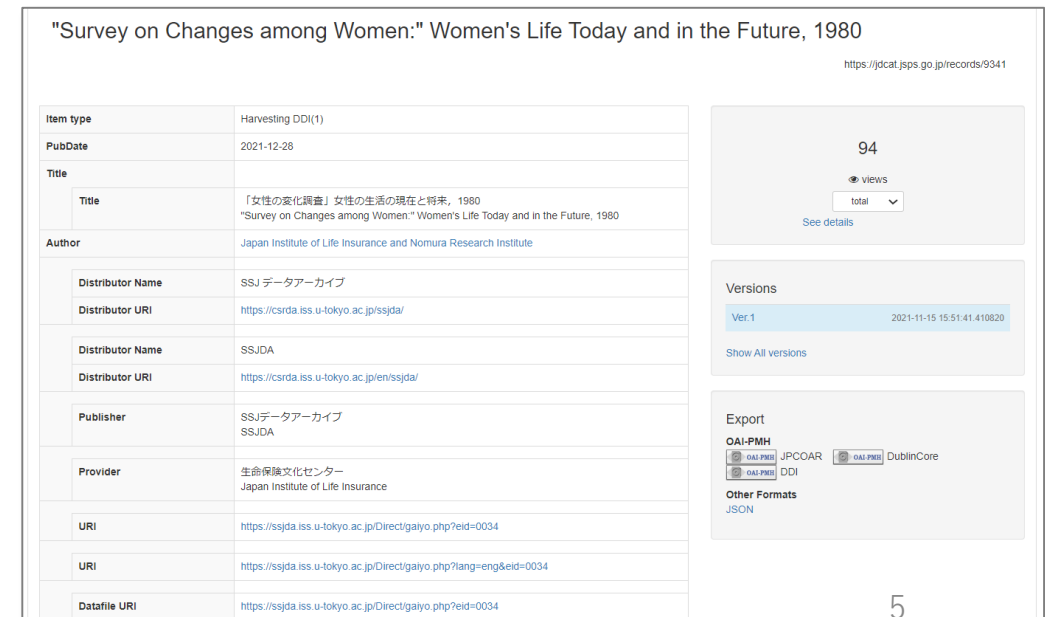
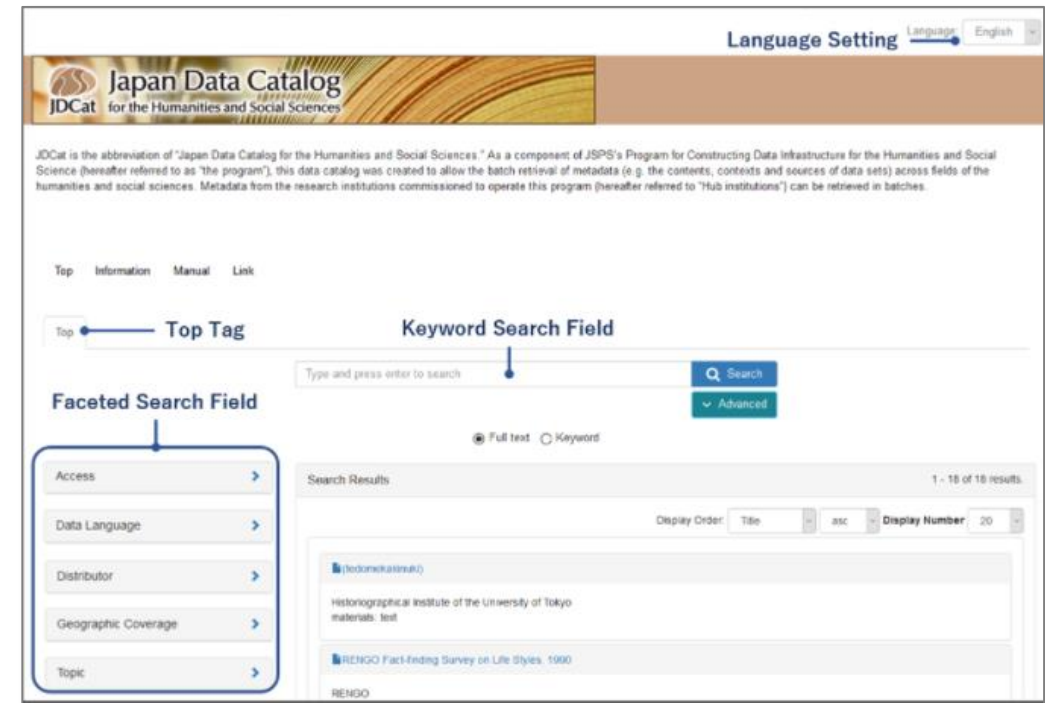
# Ongoing Data Infrastructure Projects

- Translation of metadata and major datasets into English
  - More than 50% of the metadata sets have been translated, and around 30% of metadata sets have been released
- Implementation of Self-Deposit System
  - Depositors register accounts and upload the deposit data themselves. They can update their personal information and check data usage through our system any time. (Staff curate data)



# Ongoing Data Infrastructure Projects

- Japan Data Catalog for Humanities and Social Sciences (JDcat)
  - Allows batch retrieval of metadata (e.g., the contents, contexts, and sources of data sets) across fields of the Humanities and Social Sciences.
  - SSJDA is one of the hub institutions commissioned to operate the JDcat.
  - SSJDA has created and provided more than 100 metadata sets.

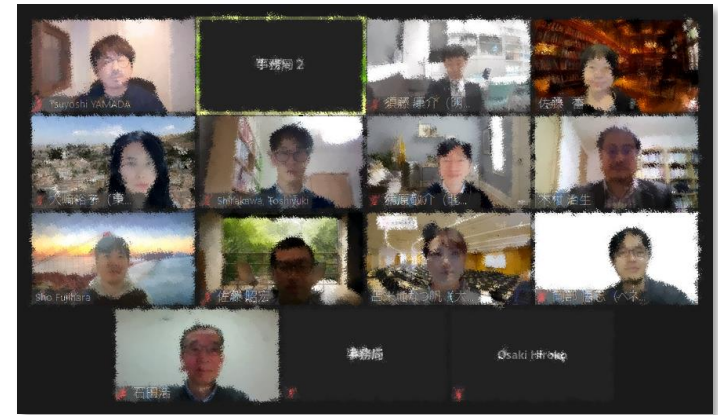

  - Japanese Life Course Panel Surveys: Focus on three demographics- youth, middle-aged, and high-school graduates
  - Special survey on the COVID-19 impact.
- Secondary Analysis Workshops (e.g., FY2021):
  - Secondary analysis of factors related to parent-child growth, using Japanese Longitudinal Study of Children and Parents
  - Study of the structure of social stratification and changes
  - Secondary analysis of welfare, education, and life during the formative period of the welfare society in postwar Japan, etc.

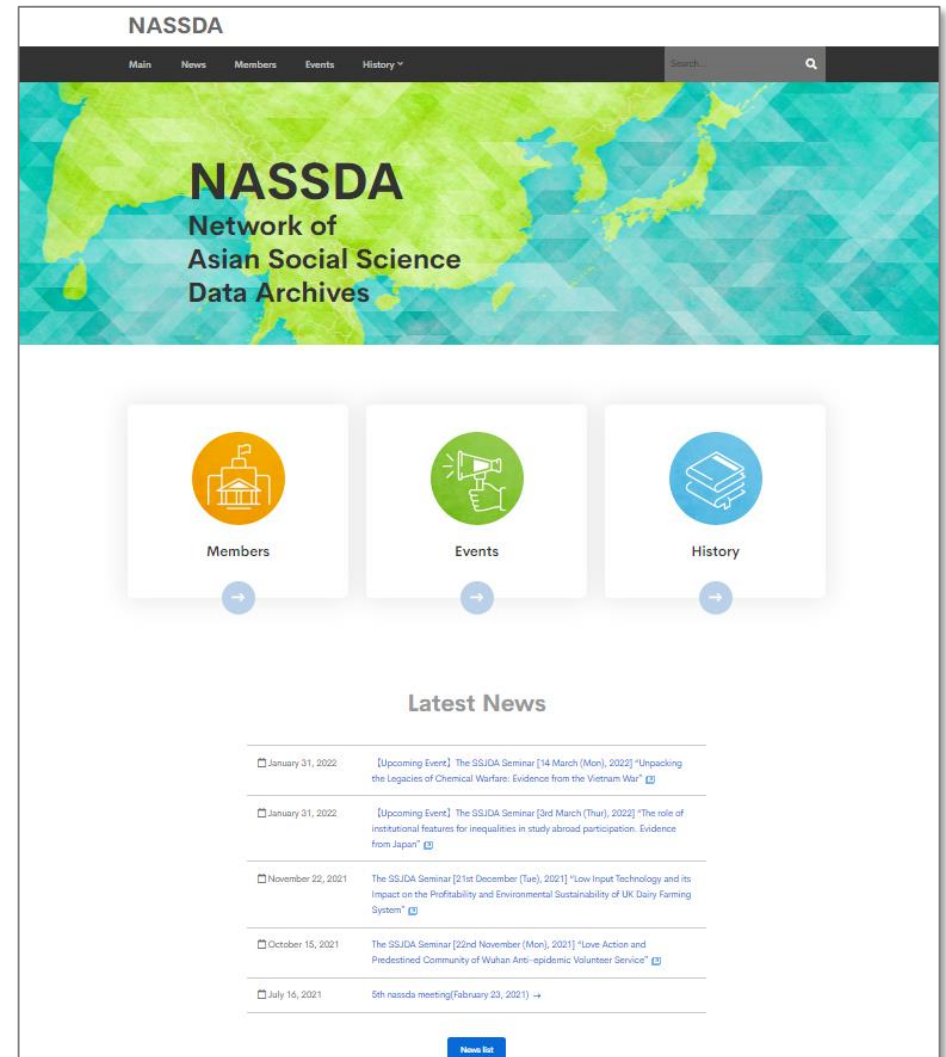
