### **Education Program**

- Upload 10 new course videos to SRDA YouTube Channel, with a total of 3,259 views in 2022.
- In 2022, CSR hosted 14 lectures, 1 workshop on Panel Study of Family Dynamics, and 1 international conference on method triangulation
- A total of 1,106 registered participants with a mean satisfaction score is 97.9 (on a 1-100 scale with higher number indicating a higher satisfaction.)

### Open Research Data Adoption

# The following factors are identified to encourage self-deposit data in Taiwan to openly share research data:

Personal drivers and intrinsic motivations

Publicly funded research data are a public good.

Requirements and formal obligations

This refers to whether formal obligations are in place, such as those imposed by the project's funder.

Trust

Researchers may openly share their data to make them transparent and to show others that they can trust the research findings.

### Open Research Data Adoption


#### Factors identified- con.

- Facilitating conditions
- There is no cost associated with depositing data in SRDA;
- (2) The self deposit platform can be used for creating, uploading, and managing deposits;
- (3) Data management guidance and support are provided to ensure legal sharing and re-use of data;
- (4) Surfing on SRDA is a resource discovery trip and data citations are supported with persistent identifiers (DOIs);
- (5) New deposits are promoted to national and international researchers via newsletters, partner archives, and research organizations.


# Proportion of Projects for which PIs Agree to Openly Share Data for Project Years 2017-2021





#### **User Service Chatbot**

- Azure Cognitive Services + LINE channel
- An expertly programmed user service chatbot can answer up to 70% of simple questions
- User service agents can spend more time handling complex user issues







### A New and Innovative Website

- Redesign the SRDA website interface based on UX/UI
- Use Elasticsearch's NLP technology to meet users' expectations for data query performance
- Make the data format of the database meet the requirements of the international database communication protocol





### Future Plan

- Develop an online analysis platform to replace Nesstar
- Collect the behavior records of website users with the latest Google Analytics 4
- Keep analyzing factors influencing open research data adoption
- Promote SRDA at the International Conference on Continuity and Changes in Families in East Asia (March 24-25, 2023)
