


About KOSSDA

- holds the largest collection of digital research data in social sciences in Korea
- maintains an integrated platform of quantitative and qualitative research data and outputs
- provides a free and single point of access to a wide range of social science data in various fields
- offers an educational program of qualitative and quantitative methods workshops and hosts a variety of academic events including Data Fair and Open Social Science Data Forum
- collaborates with a number of research institutes at universities and government that have entered into datasharing agreement with KOSSDA
- is funded by the Korean government and supported by non-profit organizations


What we did: data services


Methodology workshops

- In 2023, a total of 25 courses were opened, including traditional statistical analysis methods, unstructured data analysis, and qualitative research methodologies.
- A total of 1,250 registered participants.



Research Data Week

- In 2023, KOSSDA organized the first Research Data Week
 - ✓ 1st Research Data Week
 Data for everyone
- extend KOSSDA's data fair to a three-day-long program
- aim to offer information on research data to potential data users and to support the exchange of various issues across the research data lifecycle
- 5 programs, 10 events
- No. of Research Data Week website visitors 2,000+






What we did: educational activities

- 160+ onsite attendance














What we did: research activities

- Korean Social Trends, 2023
 - The 2023 Korean Social Trends, published for the 16th time, describes the changes in our society changed due to the post COVID-19 and the mega-trends (ultra-low birth rate, superaging, centralization of the metropolitan area, etc.) based on data and statistics








- Researches on data management

- 2,000+ YouTube views









KOSSDA Website Renewal


- re-designing data ingest process

- ✓ support reliable and secure data sharing and utilization




Our plans for 2024
