### About KOSSDA

- KOSSDA ..
  - holds the largest collection of digital research data in social sciences in Korea
  - provides a free and single point of access to a wide range of social science data in various fields
  - offers an educational program of qualitative and quantitative methods workshops and hosts a variety of academic events including *Data Fair* and *Open Social Science Data Forum*
  - collaborates with a number of research institutes at universities and government that have entered into datasharing agreement with KOSSDA
  - is funded by the Korean government and supported by non-profit organizations

#### Korean Social Trends, 2024

 The 2024 Korean Social Trends, published for the 17th time, describes the changes in our society changed and the mega-trends (aspects of middle-aged adults, Al's role in the New Normal Era, etc.) based on data and statistics



#### Researches on data management

- We conducted several research to prepare for the changing data and educational environments
  - A study to resolve KOSSDA's non-archived deposit data III
  - Developing open data action plans IV: establishment of an academic research information platform network
  - A study on the improvement of qualitative data service
  - A study on the development of KOSSDA education contents

### What we did: collaborative activities

- Co-host of WAPOR 77<sup>th</sup> and WAPOR Asia Pacific 7<sup>th</sup> Joint Annual Conference
  - WAPOR was held from July 28-31, 2024
  - conference theme, "The Soul of Public Opinion Research: Liberty, Quality, and Humanity," highlights the core values that shape our field.
  - presenting and discussing in two sessions
  - KOSSDA founder Hyunho SEOK won the WAPOR Asia-Pacific Lifetime Achievement Award

### Our plans for 2025

- World Values Survey (WVS) Wave 8 Launching in 2025
  - Contributing to High-Quality Social Science Data
  - Comparative Study of Electoral Systems (CSES) Module 6 (Completed 2024)





WVS-8 survey round has also contributed towards monitoring the set of Sustainable Development Goals and the targets defined by the UN post-2015 agenda. WVS-8 questionnaire contains numerous indicators allowing to assess the status of SDGs 1 (no poverty), 2 (zero hunger), 3 (good health and wellbeing), 4 (quality education), 5 (gender equality), 8 (decent work and economic growth), 11 (sustainable cities and communities), 13 (climate action), 16 (peace, justice and strong institution), 17 (partnerships for the goals).

WVS-8 questionnaire was structured along 14 thematic sub-sections, including demography, as following:

- social values, attitudes & stereotypes (35 items);
- happiness and wellbeing (7 items);
- social capital, trust and organizational membership (43 items);
- post-materialist index (4 items);
- security (16 items);
- economic values, corruption, migration (11 items);
- science, technology, climate change (5 items)
- religion (7 items)
- ethical values and norms (16 items);
- family planning (9 items);
- political interest and political participation (34 items);
- political culture and political regimes (39 items);
- demography (24 items).
